# Greetings from Pastor Ric....

#### Have a Happy Lent!

I am happy to greet you again as the Lenten Season will be here soon! I am glad that Lent is coming, because that means that spring is coming soon too. I can't wait! But the Lenten Season is very important in the Christian Year too. I found this description of Lent on UMC.org website:

- "Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word 'lencten,' meaning "lengthen" and refers to the lengthening days of spring. The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry."
- "Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. In the early church, Lent began as a period of fasting and preparation for baptism by new converts and then became a time of penance by all Christians. Today, Christians focus on relationship with God, growing as disciples and extending ourselves, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of ourselves for others."
- "Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter" and the reverent spirit of Lent is tempered with joyful anticipation of the Resurrection."

Many Christians think that Lent is a time to give up something. A dear friend used to say that he would give up watermelon during Lent. Of course, that was a joke, that wasn't the season for watermelons, and he didn't like them anyway. Perhaps, we should agree to take up something during Lent to help up grow in spiritual depth and our faith instead.

I hope you will join us on Ash Wednesday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, for the first Simple Supper at 6:15 and the Ash Wednesday service at 7:00 pm for the imposition of Ashes on your forehead or hand. For the rest of the weeks in Lent we will read together the book "Rediscover Jesus" by Matthew Kelly. Tim Kemmis and I will lead a discussion each Wednesday evening after the meal about what we have read that week. Each day's lesson is only about 3 pages with questions for us to discuss each week.

Please join us for this Lenten Study. I am so happy for those who have already signed up. In this way, we can take up something to help us grow this Lenten Season.
